

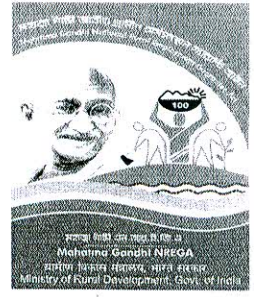

Sub: Speedy & regular submission of utilization certificate based on MIS data uploading under
MGNREGA.

This is well known to all that the object of MGNREGA is to generate 100 days employment in the rural sector of the
country including our state of West Bengal per family per year.

For implementation of the scheme fund is provided through the MORD, Govt. of India as well as by the state Govt.

It is the terms & condition of the govt. that 100% expenditure of fund allotted must be reflected in MIS within the
stipulated period of observing the guide line as fixed by the MORD and while considering the next release of installment 100%
uploading of MIS of previously allotted fund must ensured as per guide line of MORD. So every release of fund & expenditure
(100%) must reflect in MIS positively.

But unfortunately MIS uploading in every PIA level including Line Department is not satisfactory & even previous
years (2009-10) Utilization Certificate & MIS uploading position is also unsatisfactory and as a result of which fund release
through the state was stopped.

So each P.O & BDO and other PIAs (Line Department) is asked to ensure 100% MIS uploading of Schematic &
Administrative expenditure fund. Necessary passwords have already been provided to all concern including Line Department
for data uploading in MIS.

Balance available in hand as per status of MIS is annexed herewith for your ready reference.

After careful consideration in consultation with MIS status future fund will be released

Subject: Fully operationalize MIS and start reporting from 1st April, 2010

Dear

Kindly refer to DO NO. K-11011/2/2008-NREGA(MON)/TS dated 24th March, 09, 1st April, 09, 17th September, 09 and 13th Jan 2010 in which all States were requested to report on MIS.

2. You may also be aware that Ministry has decided to take all decisions for any fund releases based on the MIS reporting only. This was discussed in the PRC held in March, 2010 and in the Empowered Committee meeting held for the Labour Budget discussion.

3. States like Orissa, Kerala, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh and Tripura have started reporting on the MIS. You are requested to review the MIS status in your State and declare to be fully operational on all modules of MIS and switch completely to the MIS reporting from 1st, April 2010.

4. You are also requested to send the latest MPRs for the month of March, 2010 latest by 15th April, 2010.
